FLORIDA STATE OFFICIALS URGE CONSUMERS TO SEEK A LICENSED PEST CONTROL COMPANY TO COMBAT BEDBUG OUTBREAKS

Bedbugs were all but eradicated in this country before the pesticide DDT was banned. However, over the last decade, they've made a comeback. As the problem spreads throughout the United States, infestations have been reported across the entire Southeast, with many of these in the Jacksonville area. Adult bedbugs are the size of an apple seed but immature ones are smaller. They can be found in many places and their presence can be identified by small brownish-red to purple spotting on infested materials.

The State warns consumers not to attempt to treat the problem themselves because using the wrong pesticide or improper use of the pesticide can make family members and pets sick. Instead, officials urge consumers to choose a licensed, experienced pest control company who knows how to manage bedbugs.
